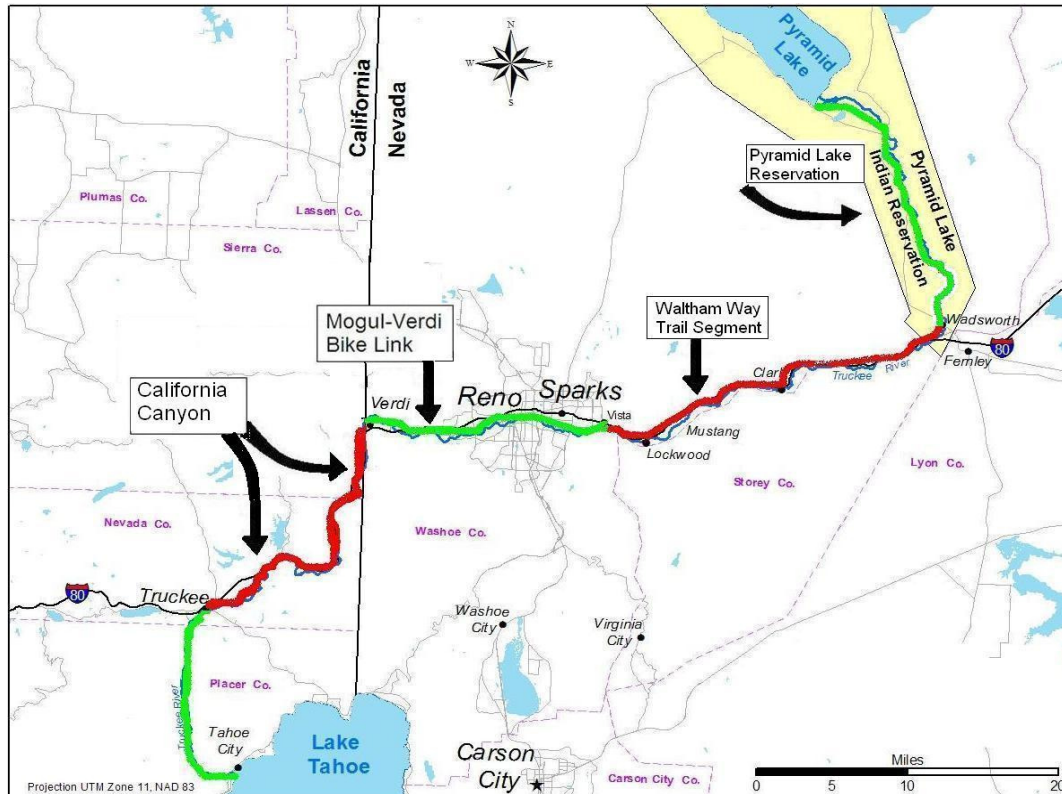

#### WHERE ARE WE IN THE BIG PICTURE?

At the end of 6 years in business, it may be good to step back and see where we are in the overall goal of creating a bike route along the entire length of the Truckee River. On the map below, green sections are rideable (thanks to work by others in addition to the Bikeway) and red sections are not (except via I-80). As you can see, it is over halfway complete: 66 miles open; 45 to go!
